Descriptive and Exploratory Questions

- Why was this case brought forward?
- Which domain of palliative care (physical, psychological, social, spiritual) is primarily involved?
- What is the main problem or question of the presenter?

Reflective Questions

- Does this case concern palliative care? Why or why not?
- What makes care in this domain difficult? (Physical, psychological, social or spiritual)
- What is the role of the other domains?
- What would you have liked to see done differently in this case?
- What went well, and why?
- Who was involved in the case?
- How did the collaboration go?
- What wishes/needs are relevant here and whose are they?

Advice Questions

- How could the situation have turned out differently?
- What advice would you give to the presenter?

Action Plan Questions

- What has the presenter learned?
- What has the team learned?
- What would you do differently next time?
- How would you approach that?
- What do you need to do so?

Description

The presenter shares the case: why this case? What themes/care domains are involved?



2

Exploration

Team asks clarifying questions and takes notes. What is the central question/problem?



3

Reflection

Presenter and team explore the situation using the reflection questions.



4

Advice

Each participant gives **one** piece of advice to the presenter. The presenter responds after all advice is given.



5

Action Plan

Use the Action Plan questions to formulate learning points and next steps.



6

Follow-up and Evaluation

The team makes agreements about next steps and when they will follow up.
